Page 71

Section 4, 2nd last line: “–49 sts now on needle.
K 1 RS row.

Page 73

Section 9, 2nd last line: “–39 sts now on needle.
K 1 RS row.

Page 77

Add to margin note:

If I think a yarn over should be twisted I will tell you to do so in the instructions. However, my result may not be the same as yours, so you should always test your first buttonhole with your button, to see that you are doing what you need to do to produce an appropriate buttonhole.

Page 82

Add note: The adult coats may stretch 2-3” in length, with wearing.

Page 83

Vitals column, 3rd bullet under You’ll need:
• 1100 (1200, 1300, 1400, 1500) for women’s sizes, (Men’s sizes may take 50-100 yds less.)

Caption: Man’s L.

Collar (for Woman’s)

Introduction, 5th line: (in blue, page 80)

Page 94

Section 1, Begin buttonholes sentence, end of line: *k7, k2tog, yo, k to end for Coat (2 buttonholes made), repeat from* until 5 buttonholes made for Bunting, then k to end.

Page 105

Caption: 13 skeins TAHKI Cotton Classic

Page 112

Introduction, insert following sentence after “coverage.” (The back is like the front—opaque to the yoke.)

Page 121

Section 1, first line of pattern:
cast on 91 (101, 111, 121, 131) sts.

Page 122

Armhole, first line: K41 (45, 50, 54, 59) sts.
Armhole, last line: k remaining 41 (45, 50, 54, 59) sts.
Section 4, first line: Return to 41 (45, 50, 54, 59) sts on holder.

Page 123

Right Front/Back, Below Armhole, first line of pattern: cast on 91 (101, 111, 121, 131) sts.
Armhole, first line: K41 (45, 50, 54, 59) sts.
Armhole, last line: k remaining 41 (45, 50, 54, 59) sts.

Right Front, Above Armhole, first line: Return to 41 (45, 50, 54, 59) sts on holder.

Page 125

Section 3, stitch pattern: *sl 1 p-wise, yb, k4, yf, repeat from*, sl 1 p-wise.

Page 137

3rd bullet: your piece should measure $3\frac{3}{4}$ – $4\frac{3}{4}$ "

Page 154

Before casting on, add following: casting off (see binding off)

First Printing 2002, Second Printing 2003

Page 110

Back & Left Sleeve, 4th row: Next row (WS) Onto larger needle (etc).

Left and Right Sleeves, Shape sleeve cap, 2nd line: Bind off 7 sts at beginning of next WS row—46 (49, 52, 57) sts remain.

Page 112

Sheer yoke: Next (decrease) row Onto larger needle, *k1, SKP, repeat from* across.

Page 113

Schematic: Increase row and Decrease row should be reversed, ie, increase row is at bottom of schematic, decrease row is at top of schematic.
