Seed Pattern (over an even number of sts)

Row 1 (RS) *P1, k1; repeat from *. **Row 2** (WS) *K1, p1; repeat from *.

Page 16

Yardage for size M is 1,000 yds.

Page 20 Basket Weave Pattern Row 2 K1, p2, k2, *p6, k2, repeat from*, end p4, k1.

Page 21 Collar

Second to last line, should read... rows even. Repeat last 4 rows 6 more times—

Page 24

Stitch pattern should read: (Multiple of 4 sts, **plus 2**, includes edge sts)
Basket Weave pattern
Rows 5 and 6 K1, *p2, k2, repeat from *, end k1.

Page 32, Dot pattern.

Row 2 K1, *k2, slip 2 with yarn in front; repeat from *, end k1.

Row 8 K1, *slip 2 with yarn in front, k2; repeat from*, end k1.

Buttonholes are not made in the crochet edging but instead:

Mark buttonholes Mark Left Front for placement of 6 buttons, the top of one button ½" below top edge, the bottom of one button about 2" from bottom edge, the others spaced evenly between.

Buttonholes for Right Front Work same as Left Front to underarm, working k2togyo buttonhole to correspond with button markers AND ending with a RS row.

Page 25 Trilling Pockets:

Cast on 34 sts.

Page 36 Garter slip pattern

Row 7 With CC, k1, *sl 1 wyib, k1; repeat from *.

Row 8 With CC, k1, *sl 1 wyif, k1; repeat from *.

Page 44, Fabric stitch

Row 4 K1, *p1, sl 1 purlwise with yarn front*, repeat from*, end p1, k1. This means that Row 4 on the chart is wrong also.

Vitals *Yardage should be:* **MC** 975 (1100, 1265) yds **CC** 445 (500, 575) yds

Page 70 Pockets:

last line with row 4. Bind off.

Page 86, BACK

Work even until armhole measures 7 (8, 8)" end with a WS row.

Page 90 Vitals Yardage

Yardage XL and XXL 2200 and 2350 yds.

Page 102, Basket Weave pattern

Stitch pattern should read: (Multiple of 4 sts, plus 2, includes edge sts)

Row 5 K1, *p2, k2; repeat from *, end k1. **Row 6** K1, *p2, k2; repeat from *, end k1.

Page 104 Garter slip pattern

Row 7 With CC, k1, * sl 1 wyib, k1; repeat from *.

Row 8 With CC, k1, * sl 1 wyif, k1; repeat from *.

Page 105, Fabric stitch

Row 4 K1, *p1, sl 1 purlwise with yarn front, repeat from*, end p1, k1.

Page 116,

Add bullet on left:

 Cut yarn and pull end through loop on hook; tighten
