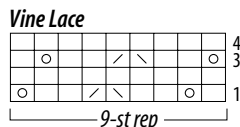
Socks, Socks, Socks!

Note: The 3rd printing (available April 2000) incorporates these corrections.

When converting the number of yards given under *Materials* in the sock instructions to meters, we made an error. To arrive at the correct number, multiply the number of yards by .9 (or to be precise, by .9114). Except on page 23, where we got it right, we divided! Take a look at Techniques & Abbreviations on p. 108—that is the correct formula. We're sorry for the inconvenience this causes those of you who think in metric.

After Bertha, p. 11: Toe: 2 rows were left out mixing up a couple of the other rows. Rnds 10–13 become Rnds 10–15 and should read: **Rnds 10–11 Knit. Rnd 12** *K1, k2tog; rep from*—22 sts. **Rnds 13–14 Knit. Rnd 15** *K2tog; rep from*—11 sts.

Vine Lace Socks, p. 43: In the Vine Lace pat, the decreases were transposed both in the instructions and in the chart. Rnds 1 & 3 should read: **Rnd 1** [K1, yo, k2, **ssk**, k2tog, k2, yo] 6 times. **Rnd 3** [Yo, k2, **ssk**, k2tog, k2, yo, k1] 6 times. Thanks to Dawna Hopeman→

Entrelac Socks, p. 56: The Right-leaning rectangle and Left-leaning rectangle should read: *Right-leaning rectangle (RRT)* With **WS**, pick up and **p** 4 sts down next triangle, **p next st**, turn. **Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 (RS)** Sl 1, k4, turn. **Rows 2, 4, 6 (WS)** Sl 1, p3, p2tog, turn. **Row 8** Sl 1, p3, p2tog. *Left-leaning rectangle (LRT)* With **RS**, pick up and k 4 sts down next RRT, **k next st**, turn. **Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 (WS)** Sl 1, p4, turn. **Rows 2, 4, 6 (RS)** Sl 1, k3, ssk, turn. **Row 8** Sl 1, k3, ssk. These corrections eliminate the need for a First LRT at beg of rnd. Rnds 1 and 3 of *Foot* should read: **Establish base: Rnd 1** . . . ; rep from* once, **turn. Sl 1, p4. Rnd 3** Work 10 LRT; turn. Sl 1, p4, **do not turn**. The “Next rnd” of *Leg* should read: **Next rnd:** . . . , then TA once, **turn. Sl 1, p4**. Thanks to Carol Breitner.

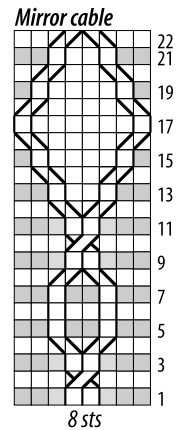
Wedgewood Socks, p. 59: Gusset: Next rnd . . . ; on 3rd dpn, **ssk**, k to end—82 sts. Thanks to Nanette Blanchard.

Ripple Socks, p. 66: The chart key has 4 mistakes: MC should be C, CC should be A, k2tog tbl should be k2tog, and ssk should be k2tog tbl. Thanks to Mimi Routh.→

Aran Sandal Socks, p. 74: Pattern Stitches, Cross Stitch Cable: Rnd 3 P1, sl 4 with yarn in back (wyib) **and dropping extra wraps**, pass the first 2 sts over . . . **Mirror Cable** (8 sts). **Rnd 1 P3, k2, p3**. Rnds 1, 3, 9, and 11 were incorrect on chart also. The 3rd square in on both sides on these rows should be gray (p on RS, k on WS).→

After rnd 2 of *Gusset*, it should read: Rep rnds 1–2 until **56** sts rem. After rnd 2 of *Toe*, it should read: Rep rnds 1 and 2 until **28** sts rem. Rep rnd 1 until **16** sts rem.



Sideways Sox Supreme, p. 76: In *Materials*, the gauge should read: 6 sts and **11 rows** to 1” (2.5mm) over pat (**2 rows St st**, 2 rows Seed st) using size 2 (2.75mm) needles. The 2 heel sts on the chart are incorrect on rows 1–46. They are charted as St st, but should be worked in pattern: 2 rows St st, 2 rows Seed St. Therefore, the written-out instructions on p. 109 have a few errors. The corrected chart, 2 heel sts only, is shown here. It is charted up to where the heel section meets the rest of the chart.→

Here are the written-out instructions corrections. **P. 109:** The **note** should read: On rows **1–46** and **61–82**, work heel sts in pat (2 rows St st, 2 rows Seed st). **On rows 47–60 and 83–96, work heel sts in St st.** (This note correction isn't in the 3rd printing.) Rows 3, 4, 7, & 8 should read as follows: **Row 3** With CC, k4, p1, k2, p1, work to end in Seed st. (“work to marker in Seed st, k2,” was removed after “p1”.) **Row 4** With CC, work to **3rd** marker in Seed st, k1, p2, k2, yo, k3. (“p2, work to marker in Seed st” was removed.) **Row 7** With CC, k6, p1, k2, p1, work to wrapped st in Seed st, work wrapped st and wrap tog, work 4 more sts, wrap next st, turn. (“work to marker in Seed st, k2,” was removed after “p1”.) **Row 8** With CC, work across in Seed st to **3rd** marker, k1, p2, k2, yo, k5. (“p2, work to marker in Seed st” was removed.) The “est” in Rows 73a–73h is an abbreviation for established.

Sunrise Socks, p. 84: Heel: the second “Next row” should read: **Next row** P13, pick up 2 sts along the edge between the needles, **p3tog**, turn.

Maple Swirl Socks, p.90: In *Materials*, the gauge should read: 5¼ sts to 1” (2.5cm) . . . For the *First sock:* E, near bottom of page, should read: *E* Pick up 7 from D, 4 from B, **25** from A, **11 from D**. Cast on 14 . . .
